Inclusions & Exclusions:

Students who are successful in securing this scholarship will be eligible to receive following things from the school subject to merit :

- ✚ Free Education till Grade 10.
- ✚ Free Books, Stationery, School Uniforms.

Eligibility Criteria: Annual Family Income falling below 3.5 lakh per annum. Residence should be within 5 Kilometre radius.

- ✚ Proof of Income of all earning members in the family
- ✚ Bank Statement of all earning members in the family
- ✚ Residence Proof (even rental will do)
- ✚ Aadhar Card of all members living in the family
- ✚ Birth Certificate of the Child
- ✚ Progress Report of Student for present year & previous year.
- ✚ Medical History of the Child

Conditions for Grant of Admission

For Grade 3 and above - Clearance of Entrance Test In

- ✚ English
- ✚ Mathematics
- ✚ Hindi OR Marathi

Entrance test will be based on syllabus of previous grade. Based on principles of equity in the exam process, test papers used will be those applicable for a grade lower. For Nursery to Grade 2, admissions will be based on interaction with parents and child.

Rules & Regulations applicable while at school:

- ✚ Behaviour while at school has to be impeccable. Use of abusive language or bad words will not be acceptable.
- ✚ Students need to follow all hygiene norms like regular bathing, trimming and oiling of hair, wearing clean uniform and such other norms as are applicable to all other students.
- ✚ Students need to maintain good academic record of securing minimum of 50% in the overall results and keep up with class activities.
- ✚ Students need to be regular and punctual in their attendance. Excess of leave will not be acceptable.

Any deviation from this norm will invite disciplinary action. If there are more than 3 instances of major deviation, it may lead to withdrawal of Scholarship.
